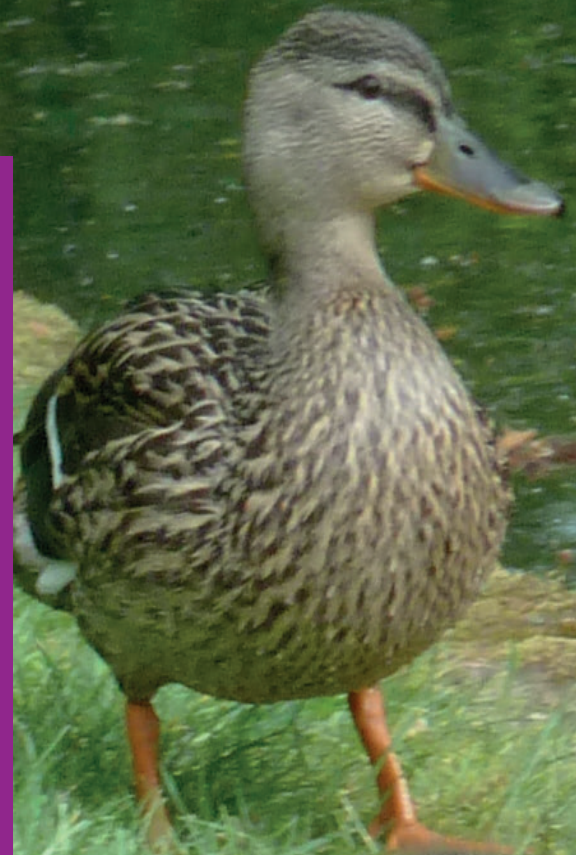




Welcome to the April 2025 issue of the Bromley Environment Network newsletter

It aims to provide guidance and support to those in the borough who are concerned with or have influence over Bromley's biodiversity.

We are asking for help with recording some of the species in trouble in Bromley Borough. As dehydration is a problem for animals in hot weather we are also making a plea for everyone to leave out some clean drinking water accessible for animals from small insects to foxes and hedgehogs this summer. Thank you for your help.

New Community Garden in Orpington Gets Go-ahead

A new community garden is set to take root in Orpington, bringing together local residents in a shared effort to transform an unused patch of land into a thriving green space. Approved by the Bromley Council, the project will be developed on land between Hillview and Orpington Station, initially under a trial period to assess its long-term viability.

This initiative, spearheaded by the Knoll Gardeners group, offers an exciting opportunity for people who are passionate

about gardening, sustainability, and community engagement. While the garden is still in its early stages—with no formal designs yet submitted—the vision is clear: to create a welcoming space that fosters connection, creativity, and environmental stewardship.

Beyond the physical transformation, the community garden aims to be a social hub, offering a space where people can meet like-minded individuals, learn new skills, and take pride in a collective achievement.

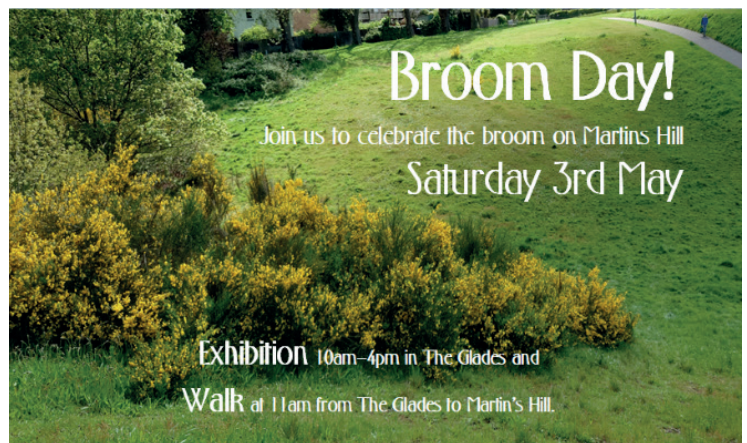

An Exhibition in the main display area on the ground floor of The Glades will tell the story of the broom and how festivals in the past celebrated the broom in flower. At 11am there will be a Walk to Martin's Hill led by the Mayor. We expect many walkers, including children, to be dressed in assortments of green and yellow, decorated with sprigs of broom! Productive Spring for Bromley Town Centre Greenspaces

Surfers for Sewage ran an event to remove the 4-years-or-more worth of litter from the 'Fishpond' lake in Church House Gardens. If anyone can spare a moment to add a Fix-My-Street for the low water level, we might be able to build up momentum to have the incoming stream flow restored to that pond so it doesn't dry up. It's quite big piece of work, so lots of public demonstration of support, through Fix-My-Street, is needed to get the council to fund it.

In the Bromley Palace Park, some enthusiastic local residents have worked hard to restore the Carriage Drive, Fernery and Cascade to their former glory; anyone who has not visited the park this spring should take a look, it is quite transformed. Unfortunately there has been some vandalism.

On Saturday 5th April, the Mayor is opening the new Bromley Town Centre Heritage & Biodiversity Trail, through all seven of the town centre green spaces. Please come along if you can spare the time. There will be new and interesting info-boards installed the previous week so you can read all the fascinating facts about our historic town centre parks.

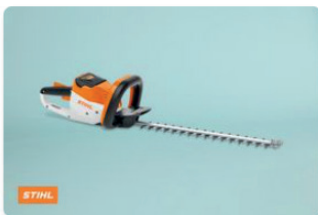

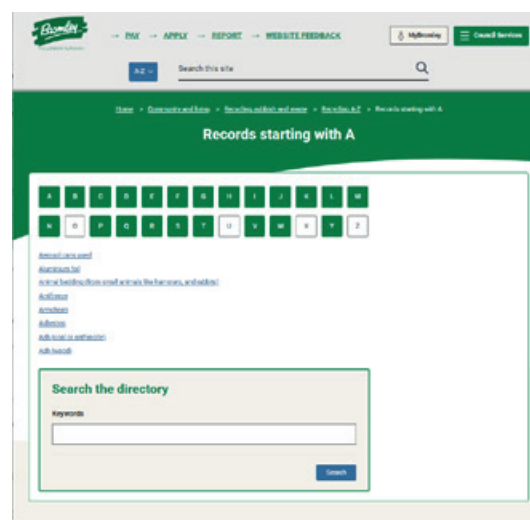
More Mindful Donation & Recycling

Further to a request from local community charity Greener & Cleaner for clarification on how to recycle certain 'tricky items' in the borough, LBB council officers Jackie Baxter and Catherine Cooke got together to create an exciting new index for recycling.

As of March 2025, the council have just launched their Recycling A-Z . They say the aim of the A-Z is to:

- encourage and support more reuse, recycling, home composting and donating rather than disposing of things in a non-recyclable refuse bin
- promote less unnecessary buying, food waste and packaging
- publicise the bulky waste collection service, green garden waste collection service, weekend green garden waste sites etc.

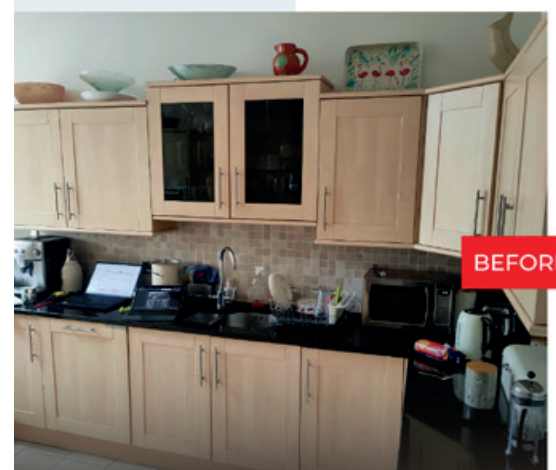
